

## Summer Academy in Paris: Deep inside Management in today's global economy

## Intensive 4-week session in July on "Global Business & Management" for students and young graduates in the city of lights

**Paris, March 2011.** The IESEG School of Management to offer the *International Summer Academy* for the fourth time at its campus La Défénse in Paris from July 1-30, 2011. Students and graduates from around the world are invited to Paris to spend four weeks of intensive study on various aspects of *Global Business & Management*.

## Lectures in Social Responsibility and Cross-Cultural Marketing

Instructors from IESEG's faculty as well as IESEG's global partner universities will lead seminars and lectures on current topics such as *Global Finance*, *Social Responsibility*, and *Cross-Cultural Marketing*. Participants in the Summer Academy can earn academic credit for the successful completion of various modules.

All instruction will be in English, although French language courses at all levels will also be offered. An introduction to the "French way of life" is an integral part of the curriculum, and excursions are planned that include a trip to Versailles, boating on the Seine, and picnics in the gardens of Paris.

Participants will be housed on the historic campus of the Paris *Cité Internationale Universitaire*. Last year, 60 participants from 19 countries took part in the International Summer Academy.
