

French language course - Intermediate
Paris, July 2013
33 contact hours / 4 ECTS credits

Course Objectives:

- Develop linguistic structures of the intermediate level.
- Develop active skills in the French language in the 4 basic fields (speaking, listening, writing and reading) by the proposal activities.

Course description:

After the intermediate French course the students would be able to improve their confidence in the different contexts like: writing, using the different structure components: grammar, conjugation, phonetic and vocabulary; speaking in several situations of the daily life; listening, having the capacity to understand French of a native speaker and another francophone cultures; reading newspapers, magazines articles, literary texts and more.

Daily Activities:

All daily communication will be carried out in French. Fluency is aided by the everyday use of speaking and listening skills. Class participation grades will strongly reflect students' daily use of the French language and their participation in class discussions.

Course outline:

During the program, students will develop the following linguistic competencies:

- Read and comprehend stories, novellas and news in French with confidence.
- Compose different assignment handwriting about special events and daily life.
- Develop a speech about some situations in life.
- Understand TV: news, soap operas and weather channel.
- Analyze different articles, giving a point of view.
