Submission Process

Paper submissions will undergo rigorous editorial screening and double-blind peer review by a minimum of two recognized scholars.

Submission Formal Requirements

These instructions ensure we have everything required so your paper can move through peer review, production and publication smoothly. Please take the time to read and follow them as closely as possible, as doing so will ensure your paper matches the journal's requirements.

Structure: Your paper should be compiled in the following order: title page; abstract; keywords; main text with footnotes. Acknowledgments shall be referred in the first footnote.

Word Limits: Please include a word count for your paper. Papers for this journal should not exceed 50000 words, inclusive of the abstract, tables, references, figure captions, footnotes.

Style Guidelines:

Font: Times New Roman, 12 point, one-line spaced. Use margins of at least 2.5 cm (or 1 inch).

Title: Use bold for your article title.

Keywords: Please provide keywords to help readers find your article. If the Instructions for Authors do not give a number of keywords to provide, please give five or six.

Spelling and punctuation: Please ensure whichever spelling and punctuation style you use is applied consistently.

Formatting and Templates: Papers may be submitted in Word formats.

References: Please ensure whichever references format you use is applied consistently.

Checklist: What to Include

Author details. Please include the author's or authors' full names, affiliations, postal addresses, telephone numbers and email addresses on the cover page, which have to be separate from the essay/paper's text. Authors' affiliations are the affiliations where the research was conducted. If any of the named co-authors moves affiliation during the peer-review process, the new affiliation can be given as a footnote. Please note that no changes to affiliation can be made after your paper is accepted.
