More specifically, the PhD candidate will analyze the functioning of the carbon securities' markets worldwide. From a methodological point of view, the PhD candidate is expected to be able to deal with large databases using state-of-the-art econometrical methods and software's. He/she should have an appetence in conducting both theoretical and empirical research.

WORKING CONDITIONS

The selected applicant is expected to begin his/her assignment in September 2020. Gross salary will be competitive with other European research and academic institutions. The PhD student will be based in Lille (on the site of IESEG School of Management). Given its status, IÉSEG School of Management has no doctoral school. The selected candidate will have to enroll in PhD program in another institution (Guidance will be provided in that respect). The PhD student will get all the means and support to engage in innovative business relevant research projects with high potential to get published in international peer-reviewed journals.
