## **'THE ROLE OF BUSINESS IN UN CLIMATE NEGOTIATIONS AND STRATEGIES FOR EFFECTIVE ENGAGEMENT'**

## ABSTRACT

The annual COPs of the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) have become the global focal points for climate action and the subject of intense attention from public, the media and academia alike. With the adoption of the Paris Agreement on Climate Change in 2015, the UNFCCC process is transitioning away from a paradigm focused on intergovernmental negotiations towards a new chapter focused on implementation and enhanced ambition. This necessarily calls for a greater involvement from business and other non-state actors responsible for driving this change. In what ways can business organisations effectively engage in the UNFCCC process, in order to accelerate climate action and achieve their sustainability goals?
