BIOGRAPHY

José Pascal da Rocha is a lecturer, mediator and corporate consultant.

He is a lecturer with the MSc in Negotiation and Conflict Resolution program. Further, he teaches at IESEG School of Management, Paris and Lille Campus, France and at IRI-PUC Rio, Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. He sits on the Academic Scientific Council at the Center for Conflict Studies, Philipps-University of Marburg, Germany.

Pascal has over 20 years of experience in volatile environments and international mediation. He has contributed either directly or in a supporting capacity to 15 peace agreements, supporting missions of the UN, the EU, the OSCE, ECOWAS, the AU and many international and national NGOs. In his current role, he advises on the political transition in Chad. Previously, he has provided dialogue and mediation services to the OSCE Special Monitoring Mission in Ukraine.

Da Rocha also provides advisory services for US Fortune 250 and Japanes companies in change management strategies and intercultural communication, including leadership, virtual teams, organizational development, and intercultural communication.

In addition to peer-reviewed articles, he has published on international mediation, peace operations and peace agreements, political mediation, and structural vulnerability assessments.
